

Travel Reimbursement Stipend Information

Fall 2024

We are delighted that you are considering the University of St. Thomas School of Law for your legal education. We recognize that you may not have the opportunity to visit every institution that you may be considering, especially one located a distance from your home. Therefore, it is our pleasure to inform you that you may be eligible for a travel reimbursement stipend to visit our campus to attend the Admitted Applicant Program (Friday, April 5, 2024) and/or meet with the Admissions Office. The visit must take place prior to your deposit deadline to qualify for the travel stipend.

For those of you who live outside of the 5-state region (IA, MN, ND, SD, or WI), we will reimburse you up to \$400 for your expenses including: airfare, train, motor coach/bus travel or mileage for automobile travel and hotel accommodations. If you live in IA, ND, SD, or WI, or more than 100 miles from Minneapolis/St. Paul, we will reimburse your expenses up to \$200 including: mileage (58.5 cents/mile) and hotel accommodations.

To be eligible for the travel reimbursement stipend up to \$400, you must:

- (1) Reside outside of the 5-state region (IA, MN, ND, SD or WI);
- (2) notify us of your intent to attend the upcoming Admitted Applicant Program (Friday, April 5, 2024) prior to your arrival or schedule an individual visit before your tuition deposit is due;
- (3) submit original receipts no later than 14 days after your visit.

To be eligible for the mileage reimbursement stipend up to \$200, you must:

- (1) Reside in IA, ND, SD, or WI or more than 100 miles from Minneapolis/St. Paul
- (2) notify us of your intent to attend the upcoming Admitted Applicant Program (Friday, April 5, 2024) prior to your arrival or schedule an individual visit before your tuition deposit is due
- (3) submit original receipts no later than 14 days after your visit.

The Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport (MSP) is less than 20 minutes from our campus and our downtown location provides a variety of lodging options. The light rail system, Amtrak rail and Greyhound bus depots are all within a short walking distance of the law school. The Doubletree Guest Suites Hotel and the Millennium Hotel are conveniently 1 block from the law school. For a full list of hotels in downtown Minneapolis, visit: www.minneapolis.org/hotels.
